Notes from the Management Committee for Tutors and Students, April/May 2015

Welcome to the second term for 2015 at Aspley Classes for Seniors. As you will be aware, classes start in the first week of May and continue for the usual seven weeks (until June 20).

Our classes were strongly supported in Term 1 this year, with a total of 270 enrolments. Of these, 144 had re-enrolled for Term 2 by the end of Term 1; re-enrolment at the end of the term, rather than waiting until the start of the next term, is encouraged as it assists our coordinators with the processing of the enrolments and helps us to be better organised for the next term's classes.

We have one new class this term – a Discussion Group on topics of mutual interest – which will meet on Thursdays at Aspley Uniting Church at 11.00 am. If you have opinions you would like to share and discuss with others, this could be your opportunity.

Also at 11.00 on Thursdays is our continuing series of the popular weekly lectures. This term's topics mainly cluster around a range of early Australian experiences. You can enrol for the whole seven lectures each term, or just turn up whenever there is a topic of special interest for you and pay the \$4 casual fee each time.

Sadly, however, our "Singing for Pleasure" group is not continuing this term. We hope it will not be long before we have a singing group up and carolling again. If you are interested in this area, why not speak to one of our co-ordinators?


